

MEMBERS CODE OF CONDUCT

Anyone found to be smoking or vaping will be asked to use a designated area if appropriate.

No drugs or alcohol are to be brought to a session.

Persons who are affected by any form of drugs or alcohol are not permitted at the session and will be supported accordingly to exit the session.

All members must complete a membership form to register and pay any entrance fees required.

Appropriate dress and footwear should be worn at all times.

When leaving sessions please do so quietly and be considerate of local residents.

Members of staff have absolute authority to take whatever measures are necessary to ensure the safety of Inspire Youth Yorkshire members.

Any Members who not comply with the above, will be given 2 verbal warnings, after that staff will make the decision to ask the member to leave the session or close the activity in response to the code of conduct being broken, Parents will be informed where appropriate and members may receive a ban from provision for upto 2 weeks depending on the severity.
